Before one starts the second part of the sonata, please lock these five notes with the sostenuto pedal.
Use a little weight for the high E.
These notes remain locked for the whole movement.

1 *(sempre) p* *mp* *(p)* *con Ped.* *(*) divide the main line also between two hands*

6 *mp sub* *p sub* *mp* *p* *(**) Bb4: loco*

9 *poco f* *p* *pp* *pp* *(***)*

(*) The 2nd part is largely based on a second movement of an early sonata attempt (from 1980), already composed for Roland Peelman.
